The public hearing will be held to gather public input on the draft City of Glendale's Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan, titled *Connecting Glendale 2020*. The Plan is intended to help guide, identify and prioritize bicycle and pedestrian needs and provide recommendations to meet the needs of Glendale's residents and visitors. This Plan is designed to be used by City officials as a policy guide for safety enhancements, sidewalk development, on-street bicycle network and trail development, and facility improvements over the next five years and beyond. It identifies existing gaps in the bicycle and pedestrian transportation network, prioritizes improvements to the network, and identifies funding sources for future projects.

A draft of the *Connecting Glendale 2020* Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan is available for review at City Hall and on the City's website (<https://www.glendale-wi.org/797/Glendale-Bicycle-and-Pedestrian-Plan>). Residents are encouraged to review the plan and submit written comments before the public hearing. All written comments will be forwarded to the Plan Commission members.
